Call for papers

The Slovenian Nursing Review (Slov Nurs Rev, Slovenian title Obzornik zdravstvene nege) is a peer-reviewed journal of Nurses and Midwives Association of Slovenia that seeks the submission of unpublished articles on current nursing, midwifery and health-related issues. For more than 48 years, the journal has explored different facets of nursing and midwifery, research and education. It is designed to respond to the needs of practitioners, researchers, educators, and administrators who develop, promote, and apply evidence-informed knowledge in their lives and work.

The journal seeks to exchange the knowledge that is directly relevant to all spheres of nursing and midwifery. It publishes papers relating to a range of themes within the context of nursing and midwifery, across all care sectors and care settings.

A strong emphasis is placed on research, theory, practice, policy and education and promotes critical debate on the art and science of nursing and midwifery practice. Central to Slov Nurs Rev's scope of interest are the developments in practice, testing, dissemination and application of clinical knowledge and theory, development of clinical research, evaluation, evidence-based practice and scientific enquiry, nursing intervention, social interaction and models of nursing care, methodological innovations, education of nurses, role development, examination of decision-making, interdisciplinary team work, as well as legal and ethical issues in nursing.

Further, the journal seeks to enrich insight into clinical practice and the implications for nursing intervention and models of service delivery.

Its aim is also to share critical information, exchange experiences and strategies, communicate research findings and discoveries, articulate important conceptual and theoretical perspectives, evaluate relevant literature, and express policy and practice initiatives and issues. It endeavours to attract a wide readership that embraces experienced clinical nurses, teachers, student nurses and those who support, inform and investigate nursing and midwifery.

The articles in this quarterly periodical are externally reviewed. Some original scientific articles are published in the English language. The Slov Nurs Rev is indexed and abstracted in CINAHL, COBISS.SI, BIOMEDICINA SLOVENICA

Published four times a year, Slov Nurs Rev welcomes manuscripts from practitioners, researchers, educators, and other health professions on issues that have a direct impact on nursing practice.
